

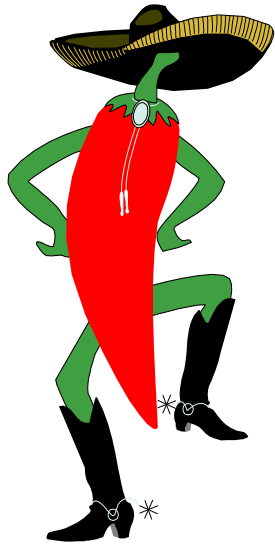

George has represented over 75 LGBT individuals who feared returning to their home countries due to persecution based on their sexual orientation. LGBT asylum is a form of immigration protection, which is often unknown to the many people who qualify and desperately need it.
