National Transgender Day of Remembrance

Saturday, November 20th

The Transgender Day of Remembrance was set aside to memorialize those who were killed due to anti-transgender hatred or prejudice. The event is held in November to honor Rita Hester, whose murder on November 28th, 1998 kicked off the “Remembering Our Dead” web project and a San Francisco candlelight vigil in 1999. Rita Hester’s murder — like most anti-transgender murder cases — has yet to be solved.



Although not every person represented during the Day of Remembrance self-identified as transgender — that is, as a transsexual, crossdresser, or otherwise gender -variant — each was a victim of violence based on bias against transgender people.

We live in times more sensitive than ever to hatred based violence, especially since the events of September 11th. Yet even now, the deaths of those based on anti-transgender hatred or prejudice are largely ignored. Over the last decade, more than one person per month has died due to transgender-based hate or prejudice, regardless of any other factors in their lives. This trend shows no sign of abating.

Join us at the Pride Community Center on Saturday, November 20th at 6:00-7:00pm for a Transgender Day of Remembrance Candlelight Vigil to mourn and honor the lives of our brothers and sisters who might otherwise be forgotten.

Freddie Johnson and Jane B Roy (weed) will be presenting your options for a home funeral followed by a green burial at Prairie Creek Conservation Cemetery (PCCC). PCCC is a "green" burial ground within a protected conservation area. It's a gorgeous piece of land just outside of Gainesville near the



Hawthorne Bike Trail. Green burial uses biodegradable containers and avoids embalming fluids and vaults.

Conservation Burial goes a step further to channel burial fees toward land acquisition, protection, restoration, and management. We can reclaim the rights and privileges of caring for our dead and nurturing Mother Earth in the process.

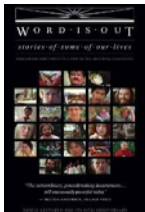

November 26: "Word is Out"

More than two dozen men and women of various backgrounds, ages, and races talk to the camera about being gay or lesbian.

Their stories are arranged in loose chronology: early years, fitting in (which for some meant marriage), coming out, establishing adult identities, and reflecting on how things have changed and how things should be.

December 31: "Little Ashes"

In 1922, Salvador Dali arrives at the university; 18 years old and determined to become a great artist. His bizarre blend of shyness and rampant exhibitionism attracts the attention of two of the university's social elite - Federico Garcia Lorca and Luis Bunel. As time passes, Salvador feels an increasingly strong pull towards the charismatic Federico. Salvador and Federico draw closer, sharing their deepest beliefs, inspirations and secrets, convinced that they have found a kind of friendship not dreamed of by others.

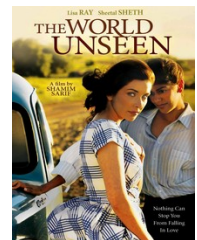


November 7: "Gaudi Afternoon"

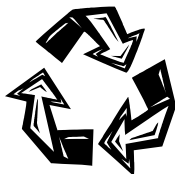
